

NVivo Q&A

Q: What are the possibilities for multiple people working in the same file simultaneously? And will such feature be freely available or is it an add-on that I'd need to buy access to?

A: With NVivo 14 and the add-on module Collaboration Cloud, several collaborators can work in the same file simultaneously. The real-time collaboration in a cloud project is only available if you have a subscription for the add-on module Collaboration Cloud.

Q: Is it possible to work with different OS (Windows, Mac) in Collaboration Server?

A: NVivo Collaboration Server is only available for NVivo for Windows. If you want to collaborate in real-time with Mac and Windows, you will need to use NVivo 14 plus Collaboration Cloud. (Please note that in the first release only Windows users with a subscription can upload and share projects.)

Q: Is it possible to use a local server for real-time collaboration instead of cloud? And will this cost extra?

A: Yes, you can use the NVivo Collaboration Server (Windows only). It can be added to an ELA license.

Q: Will the Cloud location be covered by GDPR/privacy provisions and/or be compliant?

A: Yes, it is GDPR compliant.

Q: Can you code a whole file?

A: Yes.

Q: Could collaboration cloud replace NVivo Server?

A: The NVivo Collaboration Server will still be available, as some organizations prefer to store data on their own servers instead of in the cloud.

Q: What will happen with Collaboration Server in NVivo 14?

A: Collaboration Server for NVivo 14 will be available soon.

Q: Hi, can you please explain how to attribute those values to the cases?

Q: What about the metadata, does it tag along and wind up in the file classification as is the case if you import contents from other reference management software?

A: Yes, the metadata is imported as well, so that you can use it in queries etc..

Q: Would you say that Citavi works better with NVivo, than for example EndNote or Zotero?

A: The Citavi integration allows you to import the knowledge items as codes etc.. This is not possible if you import from other reference management tools.
